**Police Report:** By Mayor Conway. April was all quiet in Rolling Fields. The Police will begin patrolling the Louisville Country Club, at LCC expense, June 2008

**Prior Meeting minutes:** 4/17/08 Minutes approved

**Bauer Property Update:** Notice to demolish has been posted, 5/15/08. In 30 days work could begin. Neighborhoods are organized to voice opposition to stop demolition. Landmarks meeting that was scheduled for Jun 19<sup>th</sup> will be moved up. Richard Jett (Director of Landmarks Staff) feels as to designation of the property as “historic” is very probable.

**RESOLUTION 08-01** – regarding support of Bauer historic designation petitioners by Commission. Commissioner Risley motioned to approve, seconded by Commissioner Moffet, passes unanimously.

**Newsletter articles:** Last “official” newsletter with launch of city website. Articles were submitted, comments solicited. No objections.

**Budget:** First reading of ‘08-’09 budget. Tax rate to remain same, 15.8%/\$100 valuation, and a 4% prepayment discount offered. No new initiatives proposed.

**New Business:** Consider curbside leaf vacuuming like City of St. Matthews. Mayor Conway will call St. Matthews to see possibility of subcontracting their service.
