

MINUTES
Regular meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission
August 16, 2007

Those present – Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, Cliff Kraweic, Lynn Risley, Chief Kelly Spratt, Councilperson Ken Fleming/Aide Jennifer Osbourne.

Councilman Fleming:

B'boro Road Safety. - Provided comprehensive update of Brownsboro Road Corridor safety study (attached). Reported that he is working with a representative for the Rite-Aid/DairyMart/NatCity property who has given him an indication that he is receptive to what is being discussed. He plans to talk with the 2nd Pres Church Building Committee regarding plans but has not scheduled meeting. Dentist at Old B'boro and US42 is OK with what has been done.

Mayor Conway emphasized need for communication and requested that he be advised/copied regarding any developments as the project proceeds. Councilperson Fleming would not commit to that, suggesting Mayor Conway call him if he wanted updates.

Urban Agenda – Mayor Conway asked Councilman Fleming for update regarding Urban Agenda which is being coauthored by Metro Council and Lexington/Fayette County. Concern was that items that affect “governance” issues, particularly small city governance issues may be incorporated in legislative agenda.

Councilman Fleming stated that primary purpose was to redistribute road funds throughout state. Asked for reassurance that governance was not included – Ken was vague. When asked to be “vigilant” regarding these issues, Ken, although acknowledging that he has made efforts to support small cities (siting revenue sharing for interconnects with Metro) was noncommittal.

Police Report: Chief Spratt reported that Rolling Fields was quiet. He also reported that Pat O’Dea’s homicide investigation in Caperton park, since a Metro Park, is being handled by Metro.

Minutes: Commissioner Moffitt motioned to approve minutes from July 19, ’07 Commissioner Kraweic seconded. Unanimously approved.

Ordinance 7-3 and 7-4: Mayor Conway gave first reading.

Being no further business, meeting adjourned 9:20 p.m.
