February 12, 2009

Those present – Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, Cliff Kraweic, Sheila Oliver, Clerk Brenda Conway. Resident Paul Moffett.

**Police Report** – Chief Spratt reported that a Jeep had been stolen from the Church parking lot. He also reported that suspect has been apprehended regarding the break-ins in Indian Hills in December. Suspect apparently was looking for prescription medication.

**Prior Meeting Minutes** – motion moved to approve January minutes by Commissioner Kraweic, 2<sup>nd</sup> Commissioner Moffet, unanimously approved.

**Treasurer’s report** – Mayor Conway will check to see if Countrywide has forwarded tax receipts on behalf of several residents. These receipts had not been received as of last month’s meeting.

**Signage for Rolling Fields** – Discussion as to: where to place a Rolling Fields signature sign at Country Lane and replacement of sign at Pennington entrance. Mayor Conway sited that the Pennington sign is actually a Rolling Fields condominium sign, and said he would contact condo assn. President to see if we can provide an incentive to upgrade this sign. Country lane sign is problematic in that we have no “public” space. Commissioner Oliver volunteered to talk to Julia Leggett regarding the possibility of using a corner of her yard (Club/Country) for understated signage.

**Ice Storm Debris Pickup** – Mayor Conway reported that necessary paperwork has been submitted to Metro and State to qualify for FEMA assistance for debris pickup as a result of icestorm on 1/27. Although this is an extraordinary non-budget expense, the City anticipates FEMA will reimburse 75%, KY 12%, leaving 13% for Rolling Fields. Residents have expressed great appreciation for the prompt and thorough debris pickup.

**Honda generators** – Commissioner Kraweic suggested putting an endorsement of Honda “super quieter” generators on the website.
