

MINUTES
Regular meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission
6:30 pm/2nd Presbyterian Church
March 12, 2009

Those present – Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, Cliff Kraweic, Sheila Oliver, Carolyn Wettterer, Clerk Brenda Conway. Chief Kelly Spratt. Resident Paul Moffett.

Police Report – Chief Spratt reported all is quiet in Rolling Fields. He has received a directive from Indian Hills to cut back on traffic warnings and issue citations. Commission verified that will not be the case in Rolling Fields.

Crime Alert – Chief had sent CRIME ALERT sign-up information to Mayor Conway who has posted on website and will include in next newsletter.

Prior Meeting Minutes – motion moved to approve January minutes by Commissioner Kraweic, 2nd Commissioner Moffett, unanimously approved.

Signage for Rolling Fields – Mayor Conway reported that he had met with Mary Jane Shaughnessy (President/Rolling Fields Condo Assn) regarding signage for Condos at Pennington entrance to City. He offered assistance (maybe financial) if the association would consider replacing or eliminating the sign. Mary Jane agreed the sign was an eyesore and said the concern would be passed on to the Assn at next meeting.

Ice Storm Debris Pickup – Mayor Conway reported that the cost to Rolling Fields will be roughly \$5,000 (\$20/household) for the special Ice Storm cleanup. Commissioners reported positive feedback from residents regarding this pickup. Metro has reported that it will have a final sweep “before Derby”.

Browning property on Canoe – property continued to be neglected. Mayor Conway reported that phones have been disconnected but he will write a letter to Mr. Browning advising his of the City’s code and possible sanctions.
