November Police Report: The November IHPD report was given and submitted by IHPD Chief Spratt via email to Mayor Conway.

November Minutes: The November minutes were approved. Commissioner Wetterer moved to approve the minutes and Commissioner Moffett seconded the motion..

Stop Sign at the Corner of Swing and Basswood for East-Bound Traffic:

Mr. George Dick sent a letter to request reconsideration of the stop sign placed at the corner of Swing Lane and Basswood Lane. He plans to attend the Commission meeting in January to address the Commission regarding the issue of the new stop sign.

Curb Report: Commissioner Tafel phoned in his report to Mayor Conway. The test curb has been installed at Maxine Bird's residence at the corner of Pennington Lane and Rolling Lane. We will wait for a period of comment and feedback from citizens and will modify the curb as needed.

Property at 3720 Canoe Lane: Mayor Conway spoke with the IPL (City of Louisville Inspections, Permits and Licenses) inspector Jim Warner. Mr. Warner proclaimed there are two violations – downspouts and a collapsing deck. Apparently the mulch pile is not a violation. According to Mr. Warner, because the house is not inhabited, there are no safety issues posed by these violations, so a grace period of three months is given to the homeowners to rectify the problems listed,
