

# MINUTES

## ***Regular Meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission***

*6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church*

*May 10, 2012*

**Those Present:** Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioner Beth Moffett, Commissioner Carolyn Wetterer, Treasurer Joanna Nugent, Indian Hills Police Chief Kelly Spratt, and Clerk Rachel Schrepferman.

**April Police Report:** The April IHPD report was given and submitted by IHPD Chief Spratt.

**April Minutes:** The April minutes were approved as amended.

**Treasurer's Report:** Treasurer Joanna Nugent presented budget information. Property tax rates were dropped to 13.8% from 15.3%. All property taxes were collected with the exception to one resident. Property Value Assessors (PVA) office has sent the estimates for this next year so that we will have a better idea on our revenues for 2012. Eighty five percent of the citizens take advantage of the early payment discount and that discount has been increased to 5%. There was a large increase in the amount of money received from insurance taxes. The State of Kentucky has increased the revenue to Rolling Fields for our police protection. The City of Rolling Fields finally received reimbursement from the ice storm of 2010 and that was added to the budget totals. A bi-annual bid for sanitation services was sought and the decision to stay with Waste Management was made based on their prices and services.

The official first reading of Ordinance 12-03, An Ordinance Relating to the Adoption of an Annual Budget for the City of Rolling Fields, Kentucky, for the Year July 1, 2012 Through June 30, 2013, Estimating Revenues and Appropriating Funds for the Operations of City Government, was concluded.

The official first reading of Ordinance 12-02, An Ordinance Relating to the Levy of Ad Valorem Taxes of the City Purposes for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2013 was concluded.

**Solicitor's in Rolling Fields:** An official first reading of Ordinance No. 12-1, An Ordinance Creating Regulations for Door-to-Door Sales and Peddlers was concluded.

**Property at 3729 Canoe Lane:** An official letter was mailed by Mayor Conway to the property owners regarding violations of Rolling Fields ordinances and the resolution of the maintenance if conducted by the City of Rolling Fields. A date of May 14, 2012 was the given in the letter to resolve the issue or actions would be taken by the City.

**Adjournment and Next Meeting:** The meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 14, 2012 at 6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church.
