

MINUTES

Meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission

6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church

May 9, 2013

Those Present: Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, Dan Tafel, Carolyn Wetterer, Clerk Rachel Schrepferman, and Indian Hills Police Department Chief Kelly Spratt

Police Report: The April IHPD report was submitted by IHPD Chief Spratt.

Minutes: Commissioner Wetterer moved to approve the minutes from April with noted corrections. Commissioner Tafel seconded the motion. The April minutes were approved and corrected minutes will be submitted into archives. Commissioner Wetterer moved to consider the minutes from the Special Meeting held on March 21, 2013 at the June meeting to give time to make the necessary changes to the minutes. Commissioner Moffett seconded the motion. The motion was approved.

Ordinance Concerning Nuisances and Buildings & Improvements: The Commission discussed the issue of Ordinance 07-04, Section 2 (B) (15). Commissioner Wetterer moved to amend the ordinance to allow for commercial yard services to occur on Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Commissioner Tafel seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

City of Rolling Fields Budget 2013-2014: Mayor Conway provided an explanation on the proposed budget for the fiscal year 2013-2014. Our PVA assessment went up one half of one percent this year which is responsible for our decreased tax burden. The Rolling Fields tax decreased from \$13.8 cents per 100 valuation to \$13.4 cents per 100 valuation. The first reading of the budget commenced and the second reading will be held at the June meeting where following approval of the budget will be considered.

Brownsboro/Country Lane Landscaping: Commissioner Tafel provided information on the status of the Metro Neighborhood Development Funds grant. He has received the Articles of Incorporation for the City of Rolling Fields and is completing the application for the funds. He has received two bids for the work approved and will receive a third bid as well. If the funds are approved, the plantings and potential irrigation will be completed in the fall.

Curb Report: Commissioner Tafel reported that he has an article for the newsletter and will provide before and after photos of the "test curb." The feedback that Commissioner Tafel has received has been positive. Mayor Conway has received feedback that the rollback curbs should be replaced. Certain comments offered suggestions on filling the drainage areas with a flat stone look. Every curb was budgeted but feedback was given to Mayor Conway to not replace every curb in Rolling Fields. We will wait to hear more resident feedback once the plan is presented in the newsletter.

Water Company Project: Mayor Conway presented a blueprint of specifics on repairing the roads from the water project occurring in Rolling Fields.

Adjournment and Next Meeting: The meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m. by a motion from Commissioner Tafel and a second from Commissioner Moffett. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, June 13, 2013 at 6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church.
