Those present: Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, David Dunn, Carolyn Wetterer, resident David James.

June Police Report: Chief Spratt was out-of-town... Mayor Conway gave details for break-in on Club Lane. 2 similar break-ins (shimmed back door) happened in Indian Hills. Police detective is tracking leads. All else was quiet.

June Minutes: The June minutes were reviewed, with no corrections noted. Commissioner Moffett moved to approve the minutes, and Commissioner Dunn seconded the motion. They were approved unanimously.

Dead trees a hazard: Resident James attended to advise Commission of vine-choked trees in the gully in the 400 block of Country and Club Lanes. Commissioner Dunn suggested contacting Metro IPL as they inspect trees, site owner if required and can enforce mitigation if necessary. Mayor Conway will follow up with IPL and post letters to owners.

Brownsboro Trees: Commissioner Dunn read a recap email that Commissioner Tafel had sent him and Mayor Conway. Commissioner Tafel was not in attendance so it was suggested that we have a special meeting so the Commission could be brought up-to-speed on this situation.

Resident Communication: Commissioner Dunn asked if we had a resident master file which combines electronic and phone contact information. Mayor Conway offered that we will be publishing another City Directory this fall and he would help to garner missing data via flyers to residents. This project is put on hold until Sep/Oct.
