

MINUTES
Regular Meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission
6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church
January 8, 2015

Those present: Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, David Dunn, Carolyn Wetterer, Chief Kelly Spratt, and Clerk Barker Price

Police report: Chief Kelly Spratt reported that the number of police incidents in 2014 was consistent with recent years. For the month of December, Chief Spratt noted that there had been several incidences of UPS package theft from front doorsteps. The issue of water/ice developing on the roadway on Mockingbird Valley Road near the Louisville Country Club was also discussed, with the most probable cause believed to be an active spring in the area. Chief Spratt again noted that neighborhood break-ins can be reduced by active security alarm systems.

Treasurer's report:

December Minutes:

December minutes will be approved at the March commission meeting.

Road Repaving – Fairway Cul de sac issue:

Mayor Conway led a discussion regarding the disputed, additional charges to residents of the Fairway Lane cul de sac for repaving work in their pull-off areas. There was general agreement that, because of the difficulty of accurately assessing the scope and measurement of the additional work, the city should request affected residents to pay “their fair share” of the total additional cost as they determine to be appropriate, and in keeping with their advisement that they were willing to do so. It was agreed that a letter will be drafted, explaining this request, detailing the total cost, and hopefully resolving the issue.

New Ordinance: 14-04

Mayor Conway presented a revised draft Ordinance 14-04, clarifying and specifying building codes and requirements of the City of Rolling Fields. This document combined elements of two earlier, parallel ordinances. The commissioners were asked to review the new ordinance so that it can be discussed and voted on at the February meeting.
