

# MINUTES

## ***Regular Meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission***

*6:30 p.m. at 2nd Presbyterian Church*

*February 10, 2011*

**Those Present:** Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, Carolyn Wetterer, Treasurer Joanna Nugent, and Clerk Rachel Schrepferman

**Police Report:** The police report sent via email from IHPD Chief Kelly Spratt was briefly discussed.

**January Minutes:** Commissioner Carolyn Wetterer moved to approve the January minutes and Commissioner Beth Moffett seconded the motion. The minutes from January were unanimously approved.

**State of the City:** Mayor Conway reviewed the points presented by Rolling Fields resident Susan Simpson at the January meeting.

- Snow plowing Mayor Conway spoke with another contractor and was advised that Steepleton is the best option for us for service and pricing. Many contractors are not taking on new work. Another proposal was received by Rocky Levan Lawn Care and there were concerns that being in Fairdale may prevent the contractor from being on the job in Rolling Fields as quickly as Steepleton. The response from the past snow was very positive with the manner in which Steepleton completed their duties. A decision was reached by the Commission to continue a contract with Steepleton and to keep them informed of the condition of the streets.
- Commissioner Wetterer reported that there are three areas that seem to be much darker than other areas:
  - Stretch of Canoe Lane, but many homes seemed to be back yards;
  - Club Lane before it takes a turn toward Swing Lane (a fire hydrant is in the area where a light would be optimal);
  - Country Lane where there are vacant homes and that will most likely be resolved when families move into those homes.

**Lighting:** A motion may be presented at the March meeting from Commissioner Oliver regarding new lights and/or lights to be repaired.

**MSD Project:**

Mayor Conway reported on the activity from MSD and they are aware of the items that they need to repair, but they are waiting for the weather to break to repave the streets and will remove the Port-A-Potty.

**Bauer Property Development Update:** Mayor Conway met with Councilman Fleming and Jennifer, his assistant. They informed us that even without the development of the Bauer property that the widening of Brownsboro Road will proceed this spring.

**Rolling Fields Condominiums:** Mayor Conway reported that the walking bridge is coming down and their maintenance man is waiting for a break in the weather to remove it. They are planning landscaping, but they are waiting to see about the widening project for Brownsboro Road before proceeding.

**Newsletter:** Paul Moffett is putting the newsletter together but we still need someone to fill the content.

**Adjournment and Next Meeting:** Having no new business, the meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m. by a motion from Commissioner Wetterer with a second from Commissioner Moffett. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, March 10, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church
