

MINUTES

Regular Meeting of Rolling Fields City Commission

6:30 p.m. at 2nd Presbyterian Church

April 14, 2011

Those Present: Mayor Bill Conway, Commissioners Beth Moffett, Cliff Krawiec, Rolling Fields resident Kathy Oyler and Clerk Rachel Schrepferman.

Police Report: The report that was sent via email was reviewed.

March Minutes: Commissioner Beth Moffett moved to approve the March minutes and Commissioner Cliff Krawiec seconded the motion. The minutes from March were unanimously approved.

MSD Update:

Mayor Conway reported that the recent storm showed that the MSD work was successful for some homes and others sustained water that hadn't in previous storms. He has had no response to recent emails to MSD.

Rolling Fields' "Spring Cleaning":

Curbing:

- Mayor Conway reported that the curbing and lamp posts/stop sign and street signs are the only "common areas" the City has. Mayor Conway consulted with Chris Redner (Joe Dougherty of Louisville Paving referral) regarding repair of the curbing in the city. City road fund can be used for this repair. Commissioner Krawiec moved to seek a bid for these repairs. Commissioner Moffett seconded the motion. The motion to seek bids for the repairs was approved.

Lampposts & Street signs:

- Commissioner Wetterer had emailed photos of other neighborhood street signs and lights for consideration by the Commission. Mayor Conway had also sought prices to replace each street sign and the first bid came in at \$400/sign (Rueff) for handlettered signs. Mayor Conway reported that he has found a handyman (Bill Edwards) who thinks he can clean up our existing signs and fix our crooked stop signs (there are eight of them) at the rate of \$35/hour. If so, he suggested we proceed. Mrs. Oyler suggested we consider decal painting on the sign from www.doityourselflettering.com.
- LG&E has already begun painting and "straightening" lampposts
- Mayor Conway suggested we clean up street signage and then decide on whether different bracketing or totally new signs would be needed. Debate was referred until a full Commission would be available to discuss and vote.

Bridge at RF Condos:

- Resident Mike Poole removed the bridge by the Rolling Fields apartments and Commission moved to give him a \$50 gift certificate to Clifton Pizza.

Website Upgrade

- Mayor Conway reported that he has met with Hill Harcourt (Ashton Advertising), who is in the process of reformatting (at no additional cost to the City) our website to make it more user friendly with a calendar and a message board. Mayor Conway was requesting additional ideas for the website and Mrs. Oyler suggested listing our local businesses.

Newsletter: The Rolling Fields Spring 2011 newsletter is to be delivered tonight by IHPD.

Adjournment and Next Meeting: Having no new business, the meeting adjourned at 8:20 p.m. by a motion from Commissioner Kraweic with a second from Commissioner Moffett. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 12, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at Second Presbyterian Church
