MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION 09-01

A MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION RELATING TO WIDENING OF BROWNSBORO ROAD AT THE COUNTRY LANE INTERSECTION

At the regular monthly meeting of the Rolling Fields Commission on September 10, 2009, the Commission, acting on behalf of the residents of the City of Rolling Fields, adopted the following Resolutions, after discussion and unanimous vote:

- Be it resolved that the Commission is opposed to the expansion of Brownsboro Road to five lanes at the Country Lane intersection at this time;
- Be it resolved that the Commission requests further consideration of alternatives to reduce the speed of traffic through the Brownsboro/Country Lane intersection, to better protect school/pedestrian traffic across Brownsboro Road and preserve and enhance the green space along the intersection, including but not limited to:
 - a) left-turn protected lights in the existing traffic lanes, with a permissive green arrow,
 - b) brick paver sidewalks across Brownsboro Road,
 - c) narrowing the lanes on Brownsboro Road at the intersection, and
 - d) adding sidewalks and green space area along Brownsboro Road;
- Be it resolved that the Commission requests an immediate delay in the bid being let on the Brownsboro Road/Country Lane intersection project, in order to provide an opportunity to address the concerns and permit the input of the residents in the surrounding neighborhoods, including Rolling Fields.

Unanimously adopted at a regular meeting of the City Commission of the City of Rolling Fields, held this 10th day of September, 2009.
